I have just received the preliminary results of the 1990 FAMA pump survey from the accountants.

Consistent with past practice, I am sending the preliminary results to the pump manufacturers who participated in the survey. The "official" results certified by the public accounting firm will be mailed to Bill Bruns, Secretary of FAMA and the subsequent official distribution will be made at a later date. The numbers will remain the same.


A summary comparison of numbers for 1989 is as follows:

	<u>Single Stage</u>	<u>Multi-Stage</u>	<u>Total</u>
1990	2524	984	3508
1989	2438	1069	3507

There appears to be some confusion with respect to reporting the number of 500 GPM pumps shipped. As noted on Vickie's report only 3 companies out of 4 reported shipments in this category. I assume this was done as a result of the NFPA rating change to 750 GPM as the lowest rated pump. However, as it affects the total number of pumps shipped it may be offset by the fact that shipments to Canada are included for the first time.
