FAMA and FEMSA Win Major Victory in AFG and SAFER Reauthorization

It was a long and arduous, nerve-racking legislative process spanning over 18 months, but the reauthorization of the AFG, SAFER and the United States Fire Administration finally made it through Congress and onto President Biden's desk for signature this summer.



The legislative victory came just in time, with the looming sunset date for AFG and SAFER approaching on September 30, 2024. FAMA and FEMSA, through its GAC, played a pivotal role in its passage, meeting with key House and Senate leaders during our 2024 Hill Day and securing commitments in those meetings that the legislation would pass Congress before the sunset date. The Fire Coalition, led by CFSI, pushed the legislation across the finish line.

The law authorizes AFG and SAFER through Fiscal Year 2028 at \$750 million for each program, ensuring both continue to operate for another five years.

The GAC thanks all the FAMA and FEMSA members who contacted their Senators and Congressional delegations in support of the critical reauthorization package. FAMA and FEMSA, and the GAC, truly make a difference!
